BILLS OF INTEREST TO HERITAGE CAUCUS THAT HAVE PASSED THE LEGISLATURE

SB 5792 (Saloman) – Cultural Access programs, same requirements for all counties

Mar 6 House Floor - Third reading, passed; yeas, 80; nays, 17; absent, 0; excused, 1 with amendments.

Mar 9 Senate concurred in House amendments - Passed final passage; yeas, 46; nays, 2; absent, 0; excused, 1

HB 2405 (Duerr) - Commercial property assessed clean energy and resilience

Mar 7 House concurred in Senate amendments. Passed final passage; yeas, 93; nays, 4; absent, 0; excused, 1.

HB 2837 (Boehnke) – Expanding powers granted to state historical societies

SB 6312 (Zeiger) - Making the nonprofit and library fund-raising exemption permanent.
