SHB 1016 (Morgan) – Making Juneteenth Day a legal holiday

- April 12 – Speaker signed
 - April 15 – President signed
 - April 20 – Delivered to the Governor

SHB 1279 (Rule) - Modifying the Washington main street program tax incentive to respond to the economic impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic

- April 15 – Speaker signed; President signed
 - April 16 – Delivered to the Governor
 - April 21 – Governor bill signing scheduled for 3 p.m.

2SHB 1382 (Tharinger) - Streamlining the environmental permitting process for salmon recovery projects

- April 9 – Speaker signed
 - April 10 – President signed
 - April 13 – Delivered to the Governor
 - April 16 – Signed by the Governor

SSB 5080 (Carlyle) – Expanding allowable use of repaid local sales and use taxes deposited in the construction account for building used for youth educational programming
